# From the Bursar: Cashless Catering—Live from 1 February 2016

The biometric registration of students on Tuesday ran very smoothly. There will be further sessions next week to ensure that each student for whom consent has been received is registered before the cashless catering till system goes live on **Monday I February**. Please note the following key dates and changes:

- ♦ Monday 18 January: From this date parents will be able to put money onto their child(ren)'s lunch account(s) via the Parents' Online Payment System (POPS) at <a href="https://reigate.oasis-software.co.uk/users/login">https://reigate.oasis-software.co.uk/users/login</a> or via the <a href="link">link</a> on the front page of the school website. Top ups to your child(ren)'s lunch account(s) using POPS can be made in multiples of £10.
- <u>Friday 29 January</u>: All balances on students' old lunch cards will be transferred to students' new accounts.
- <u>Friday 29 January</u>: Last day of use for current lunch cards and cash payments.
- Monday I February: Neither lunch cards nor cash payments will be accepted in either the Sixth Form Centre or the Dining Room (PMH) every student will use his or her new lunch account.

For those pupils whose parents have not given consent for the use of their child's biometric data, there will be a till in the Dining Hall (PMH) and in the Sixth Form Centre where they may be identified by name and photograph on the new cashless catering till system. In these cases, parents are still required to use POPS to top up accounts.
