## From the Headmaster

I am thrilled this week to have received the final report from the **Independent Schools Inspectorate** following our integrated inspection in December. You will remember that RGS is deemed to be **EXCEPTIONAL** in Achievement & Learning and **EXCELLENT** in **ALL** other aspects of the inspection. I have captured many of the fabulous quotes from the report in the letter you will receive today, which I very much hope you will enjoy reading.

At this time of year **UCAS** applications are coming in thick and fast and I am very happy to say that RGS students hold more than 100 offers from top **Russell Group** universities—and counting. More than half the year group have received three offers from universities of their choice; and 26 students have received five offers already. This is a remarkably good position for the Upper Sixth Form students at this stage with more offers being confirmed on a daily basis. A number of courses and universities have not yet made any decisions at all about offers and we will give you more updates over the next few weeks. At the moment we are on track for record numbers of Russell Group offers and we have all fingers crossed for the students who still await the outcome of their applications.

Last weekend cadets from all year groups and sections attended this year's CCF Recruit Training Cadre held at Napier Barracks, Folkestone (see picture below). In spite of bitterly cold conditions, Third Form recruits excelled in all areas covering basic drill and turnout, how to conduct themselves with integrity and meet the other CCF core values. They were instructed by seniors cades, notably Amber Rothera, who delivered a fantastic lesson on major bleeds impressing the CCF Training Sgt. Awards were as follows: Best Recruit: Harvey Nutt; Most improved: Adam Browse; Best NCO: Isaac Osterreicher; and Best Cadet: Jonny Coyle. Commander Powell RNR attended on Sunday to review the parade and judged the RAF Section to be the best drill team.

- Congratulations to the UI2 and UI3 Netball teams who took part in the first round of the Surrey County Netball competition this week. Both teams played fantastic netball, winning all but one of their matches and have now qualified for the Surrey finals later this term. This success means that all five RGS A netball teams, from UI2 to the UI8 1st VII team (pictured right), have qualified for the Surrey Finals! This is a huge achievement and displays the strength and depth of netball talent at the school. Girls will be training hard and will be aiming for a top three position in the county.
- ♦ Congratulations to the UI3 Netball teams who played City of London Freeman's School on Monday. All four teams won their matches scoring a total of 66 goals versus their 28 goals! Well done.

## Cashless Catering—Live from 1 February 2016

Thank you to those parents who attended last night's Parents' Forum on the implementation of biometric registration which continues to progress well. Approximately 85% of students have registered with the remainder being done during this week. If you would like your child or children to be registered prior to the cashless catering till system going live on **Monday I February**, please email your consent (stating the names of all your children) to biometrics@reigategrammar.org as soon as possible.

You are now able to put money onto lunch accounts via the Parents' Online Payment system (POP) at <a href="https://reigate.oasis-software.co.uk/users/login">https://reigate.oasis-software.co.uk/users/login</a>, via the <a href="link">link</a> on the front page of the school website or via the Parent Portal.

#### **Key Dates:**

- ♦ Friday 29 January: All balances on students' old lunch cards will be transferred to students' new accounts.
- Friday 29 January: Last day of use for current lunch cards and cash payments.
- ♠ Monday I February: Neither lunch cards nor cash payments will be accepted in either the Sixth Form Centre or the Dining Room (PMH) every student will use his or her new lunch account.

NB: For those students who have not registered their biometric data, there will be a till in the Dining Hall (PMH) and in the Sixth Form Centre where they may be identified by name and photograph on the new cashless catering till system. In these cases, parents are still required to use POP to top up accounts.
