



## School Uniform – Girls (First to Fifth Form)

### General Appearance

A smart appearance is expected at all times. Hair must be of a simple conventional style and tied back, if shoulder length or longer. Dyed hair is unacceptable. Jewellery and friendship bands are not permitted. One gold or silver stud may be worn in each lower ear lobe. Make up and nail varnish must not be worn and if girls do so, they will be asked to remove it.

<b>Blouse</b> Plain white with rever collar	✓		✓		Short, $\frac{3}{4}$ length or long sleeved. Vests, if worn under blouses, should be plain white and not visible below the bottom of the blouse.
<b>Skirt</b> Navy	✓			✓	Nimbus, style no 40. Skirts must be knee length and not rolled up.
<b>Tights/Socks</b>	✓		✓		Tights, if worn, must be navy or black. White ankle socks may be worn (First to Third Forms); flesh coloured foot socks or white ankle socks may be worn (Fourth to Fifth Forms). Girls should have a spare pair of tights with them.
<b>Shoes</b> Black	✓		✓		Flat-heeled polishable leather shoes of simple conventional style that provide adequate support and which have straps or laces. Suede, patent leather or canvas shoes are not allowed; neither are boots or shoes with coloured logos.
<b>Coat</b>	✓		✓		Outdoor coats should be without large logos and long enough to cover the blazer. Waist length jackets are not allowed. Denim, leather and corduroy are not suitable. There is an RGS crested coat available from our on-line shop. The on-line shop will be open for a limited two week period, dates to be confirmed next term.
