One of the outcomes was that although students felt that they hear about online risks from strangers, they would appreciate more information on peer to peer incidents. This had a direct impact on the First Form Online Safety Drop Down day, where we allocated a whole session to cyberbullying and how this is dealt with in the RGS community.
